We have a young Mongolian couple who are helping us with the youth group. We are excited for them to continue to grow in their leadership and teaching. They had their first baby in February. Please pray for this area of ministry and the growth of our leaders.

In February Tsagaan Sar was celebrated. This is Mongolia's biggest holiday. It is three days of visiting family and friends in their homes. It is tradition to wear Mongolian traditional clothing and eat certain food while visiting. Me and the boys were invited to visit a couple of homes during this time. After this Holiday, the Bible College's new semester started. We have now just finished the mid-term test. Please pray for the students and staff. Please pray that God would send us more students.

I continue to teach English at a school here. My program will end at the beginning of May. By mid-May our partners, Cameron and Hannah Schmutzler, will return to America for their first furlough. They are a blessing to us and the ministry. They are an important part of the ministry here. Please be praying for them as they prepare for their furlough. Also pray that God will give me wisdom about how to cover everything in their absence.

Tammy was scheduled to return to Mongolia in March. Unfortunately, she had a medical issue that came up. She has since been to the doctors and we know what the problems are and have a treatment plan. Prayerfully she should return by the end of May. Please pray for us and her.
